**2. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING**

The minutes of the meeting held on 13<sup>th</sup> May 2019 were approved as a correct record and signed by the Chairman

**MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING.**

**3.1. Highways**

For the full list of outstanding issues consult the Highways spreadsheet. Updates, completed work or new issues which have arisen since the last meeting will be noted below.

- 3.1.1. Erection of shed on the north side of Nab Quarry and destruction of trees. No update
- 3.1.2. Surface of bend round the church –3342942 No update.
- 3.1.3. 3342942 Collapsing wall on Shrigley Road, north of Spuley Lane by the bend sign -no update.
- 3.1.4. Andy Simpson reminded of his promise to have the blocked gullies emptied. The Clerk informed Andy Simpson again but has still not received a reply.  
**Action:** Cllr. Saunders will contact Andy about his lack of response.
- 3.1.5. Parking on the road at Brookbank. PCSO Amy Hickman replied saying that the residents have received a leaflet reminding them that that it is an offence to park against the flow of traffic and when parked in a derestricted area after dark they must display a parking light. The area will be monitored.
- 3.1.6. 3360268, 3360266 references for three potholes reported on Shrigley Road near Mitchelfold. They have been logged and will be done in due course. Cllr. Boulton reported that only one has been filled.  
**Action:** the Clerk will report them again.

**3.2. Gas Lamp**

**Action:** The invoice will not be paid until Cllr. Wray receives a response to his query about the amount added to the original estimate for an additional visit.

**3.3. Lamp situated near Cherryburn**

No update available.

**3.4. PACP**

- 3.4.1. A bid for a bench for the Village Green has been submitted by the Clerk.
- 3.4.2. The bid for a new barbecue base has been accepted and the money paid.

- 3.4.3.** A resolution for the funding limit for applications to be increased to £1,000 for projects of special merit which meet the PACP's criteria, has been proposed and should be ratified at the next meeting.
- 3.4.4.** Cllr. Boulton attended the financial sub-group meeting and the AGM on 15<sup>th</sup> May. At the former it was suggested that the Council might consider putting a request in HotPott for anybody wishing to purchase a memorial bench, which could be sited on the Village Green. It was also explained that no money would be available for the light near Cherryburn as this would fall under the remit of CEC.  
At the AGM it was stated that there is still £14,000 in the kitty with another £8,000 to come. Waitrose is offering seven hours help to any group which needs it as well as promoting a Grow and Sell scheme.  
Jayne Barnes asked Cllr. Boulton to supply her with a list of all Pott Shrigley related issues.  
**Action:** as the Clerk's bid for a bench, though submitted in time to Val Burlison, failed to reach the sub-group before its meeting, any future applications should be sent to Jayne Barnes.

### 3.5. Bench on Shrigley Road

Cllr. Wray and the Clerk had researched suppliers of 'plastic wood'. The details were given to Cllr. Basford.

### 3.6. Troughs

Sheila Jenkins has agreed to plant the trough at Unwin Pool and Joyce Burton has done the other one near the school.

### 3.7. Defibrillator Cabinet

A new cabinet has now been installed by NWAS. The Clerk sent the Council's thanks.

### 3.8. High Street Community Clean Up Fund

Notification has been received that a BACs payment of £270 has been sent. It does not appear in the financial statement because it has not been reconciled.

**Action:** money from this fund will be used to buy the plants for the troughs this summer, an estimate will be submitted for the cost of bulbs for the troughs to be bought in September and the remainder will be spent on litter picking equipment. The Clerk will organise this and submit copies of the invoices/photos to CEC as requested.

- 7.2. David Garton has offered to mow the Village Green before the Rose Queen event.
- 7.3. Cllr. Basford reported a pothole 100m up Bakestonedale Road about 20m after the signs on the right.  
**Action:** the Clerk will report it.
- 7.4. Cllr. Boulton asked for the remedial resurfacing of Shrigley Road from Green Close to the aqueduct and the modifications to the 'Chevron Bend' to remain on the agenda so the Council remains aware that nothing has been done yet.
