1. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING

The minutes of the meeting held on 6th September 2021 were approved as a correct record and signed by the Chairman.

2. MEMBERS' DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

No declarations were received.

3. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING.

3.1. Highways

Updates, completed work or new issues which have arisen since the last meeting will be noted below.

New/Updated/Completed

- Fingerpost at junction of Street Lane and London Road. Cllr. Gleave from Adlington PC has the matter in hand. Negotiations are taking place between Graham Engineering and a landowner about re-siting the finger post on his/her land.
- POY1629 Double yellow lines on Pott Hall bend. Cllr. Boulton has exchanged several emails and sent a description and photographs to explain the problem to Steve Ashton, CEC traffic engineer, who is going to draft some proposals.
- Traffic Lights near Cedar Lodge. The collapse north of Brooklet Cottage will be dealt with at the same time. A site meeting took place with Jonathan MacPhie on 8th September 2021. He was going to include all aspects of the problems identified and agreed to communicate further to the Parish Council via the Clerk. Work is due to start in the next few weeks but approval is needed from the Environment Agency regarding river work.
- 3438438 the gully opposite the entrance to Mr. Simcock's field, across the road, by the brook which was blocked by debris and roots has now been cleared.

Action: The Clerk will inform CEC.

Pending

- 3438439 'Chevron Bend' two large holes in the wall following an accident.
- Remedial resurfacing of Shrigley Road from Green Close to the aqueduct.
- Project 1421 (PACP list) Modifications to the 'Chevron Bend'
- 3369619 Stones are missing from the base of the wall at the side of the bridge on Bakestonedale. Done?
- Road surface of Long Lane between Nab Quarry and Shrigley Road.
Waiting for a response about whether there are plans to fill in the potholes on the left.

3.2. CRICKET CLUB

Cllr. Wray raised the issue with Robert Street, who reported that Kevin hadn't been well but Robert would contact him on his own return from holiday on 23 September. However, he too has had great difficulty making contact. The CC are reluctant to use a paid professional as suggested by the Council.

Action: The Clerk will write to the CC committee asking for a representative to attend November's Council meeting to explain the reasons for the delay.

3.3. PACP Meeting

Poorly attended valid reasons for absence. Rosie Deverill going to set up Facebook page to encourage groups to apply for funding as there is £13,145.99 available. She has joined all the local FB groups.

Cllr. Boulton has suggested that an application to the PACP for £1,000 towards the ride on mower might be successful if the Clerk can make it fit the criteria.

Chairman, Rob Hughes suggested we provide maximum information regarding use of the Village Green. Also, we should easily maximise on the number of volunteer hours between grass mowing and the events that follow.

Ride on Mower

Crowdfunding scheme run by Spacehive. Because of the lengthy process the application incomplete when the deadline was reached.

Action: Further discussion to take place in November to decide whether the cost is justifiable even with a grant before the Clerk submits an application to PACP for a grant, where she is aware that the criteria do not really fit the situation.

3.4. Peak Park Parishes Forum AGM and Parishes Day participated in by Cllr. Goodman

AGM main points -the impact of the Covid 'lock down' measures, a meeting with area MPs to express concern over the reduction in resourcing to the NP Authority and the effects of possible re-opening of the Matlock to Buxton railway line along the Monsal Trail etc. The Forum committee is seeking additional members. The subscription is to stay at its current level.

Parishes Day- main points The Glover Review of Protected Landscapes, the PDNPA Management Plan and the PDNPA Local Plan Review.

3.5. JUMBER CLOUGH

3.6. FOOTPATHS/PNFS

Despite several requests, no response from Graham Green for estimate for renovation/handrail for steps at Jackson Brow. It would appear that he is no longer interested in the work.

Action: The Clerk will inform Nigel Howe from PPFs and leave the project now until next spring.

3.7. PLAQUE FOR OAK TREE AND HORNBEAM

Installed on Village Green. Hornbeam planted in cage built by Cllr. Basford and plaque provided by Joyce Burton installed. Oak tree plaque removed temporarily for editing.
