Cllr. Saunders - update about modifications to school corner. Cllr. Saunders sent an email to Ryan O'Rourke on 24th January. In his reply he said, " *The scheme was passed over to our contractors for quoting and I expect to hear back by the end of the week.*"

4. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING.**4.1. Highways**

Updates, completed work or new issues which have arisen since the last meeting will be noted below. Work which hasn't been completed is listed under 'Pending'.

New/Updated/Completed

- Brookbank- Cllr. Greenwood has contacted ENWL who are going to send out an engineer to investigate.
- Cllr. Lancaster received detailed response received from PC Andy Brett about traffic problems/accident at Brookbank bend. He is going to make the PCSOs aware of all the facts but although there was police attendance, as there were no injuries, the accident will not be logged.

Pending

- Culvert under Shrigley Road outside Pott Hall.
Cllr. Basford expressed concerns about the changes that had been made to the water course behind Pott Hall and the potential for flooding of the properties and ultimately the road. He has informed the residents that they should contact the Peak Park. The Clerk has supplied the contact details of an enforcement officer.
- Remedial resurfacing of Shrigley Road from Green Close to the aqueduct.
- Project 1421 (PACP list) Modifications to the 'Chevron Bend'
- Collapsed wall Bakestonedale Road
- The damaged Adlington/Poynton signpost by church wall. Ches has been reminded again with no response this time.

4.2. CRICKET CLUB

Interim invoice received from Tom Geen which was reduced after the Clerk questioned it.
Resolution: The Pott Shrigley Parish Council resolves to accept the Cricket Club's caveat to

the Deed of Covenant allowing alcohol to be sold on a maximum of seven occasions in the year. This passed unanimously.

Cllr Boulton pointed out that nowhere in the Deed of Covenant did it say that in the event of the closure of the Club, the land must be sold back to the PC for the original figure.

Action: The Clerk will contact the solicitor regarding this omission.
