5.1. Highways

Updates, completed work or new issues which have arisen since the last meeting will be noted below. Work which hasn't been completed is listed under 'Pending'.

5.2. New/Updated/Completed.

- As a result of John Goodman's report about several uprooted/damaged footpath markers in the village repairs have been done by Cllr. Basford, Dave Garton and Peter Atkinson, PROW, who was encouraged by the Clerk.
- Footpath is sinking on Shrigley Road, north of Fern Cottage – reported, examined and on list for repair.
- Modifications of pavement outside school still not done.
- Cllr. Boulton has reported the deep pothole under the aqueduct on Shrigley Road, on Fix My Street.
