**1. MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING**

**4. MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES OF THE LAST MEETING.**

**4.1. Highways**

Updates, completed work or new issues which have arisen since the last meeting will be noted below. Work which hasn't been completed is listed under 'Pending'.

**New/Updated/Completed.**

- As a result of John Goodman's report about several uprooted/damaged footpath markers in the village repairs have been done by Cllr. Basford, Dave Garton and Peter Atkinson, PROW, who was encouraged by the Clerk.
- Footpath is sinking on Shrigley Road, north of Fern Cottage – reported, examined and REPAIRED
- Modifications of pavement outside school still not done.
- Pothole under the aqueduct on Shrigley Road -repaired.
- Improvements to bend at Brookbank- Cllr. Lancaster has hit the usual no response brick wall but is in touch with the manager.

**Pending**

- Culvert under Shrigley Road outside Pott Hall.
- Remedial resurfacing of Shrigley Road from Green Close to the aqueduct.
- Collapsed wall Bakestonedale Road
- The damaged Adlington/Poynton signpost by church wall.
- Project 1421 (PAHG list) Modifications to the 'Chevron Bend'
- The broken Fence at West Park Gate car park on list for repair.

**4.2. LYCH GATE**

The cost of the full repair with replacement of the runners is possibly achievable. The PCC has promised £1,000 towards the cost.. Quotes have been received from Britannia Woodworking, (who can only do the woodwork) and Ian Greenwood. It was unanimously agreed to go ahead with the full repair. It was unanimously agreed to accept Ian Greenwood's quote of £5,350.

**7. CORRESPONDENCE RECEIVED BY THE CLERK**

- 7.1.** RingGo is the app for parking in Cheshire East car parks.
- 7.2.** Invitation to Disley Civic Service 27 October 11am. Cllr. Boulton expressed an interest in attending.
- 7.3.** Letter from Arthur Ivatts of Shrigley Road about speeding on Pott Level and the measures he's taken so far.  
**Action:** The majority of councillors acceded to his request to join Bollington in having a trial of '20splenty for Cheshire East' run by Diana Davey providing there was no financial commitment.
- 7.4.** PDNP request from Ellie Faulder to update the Parish Statement. Deadline December.

- 7.5.** Peak Parishes Forum's AGM in Bakewell on Saturday 12 October.
- 7.6.** CHALC Annual Meeting Thursday 17th October from 6pm Canalside Conference Centre, Middlewich. Cllr. Basford agreed to attend.
- 7.7.** Cllr. Lancaster received a detailed response to her request for information about the repairs to bridge on London Road and the length of time they would take. Owing to the severity of the crack in the bridge, it will the next financial year before there is any chance of the repair being finished.
- 7.8.** Boundary Commission – CEC's recommendations circulated. Pott Shrigley will be associated with Bollington.
- 7.9.** Madeline Cass asked access to water on Village Green for her wedding next summer.  
**Action:** The Clerk will tell her there is none and water must be brought.

- 8.2.** Cllr. Greenwood was successful in acquiring a grant of £350 from the NECCP to purchase bulbs and plants for the group of 'Pott Planters' who will use them to enhance the village.

- 8.4.** Cllr. Basford reported that the pavements needed sweeping but it was decided to delay the request until all the leaves are down.
- 8.5.** An articulated lorry got into difficulty at Norman's Hall bend. The police were in attendance and helped to extricate him. Unfortunately the lorry has made a mess of the verges.
